Garda Vetting Service

Did you know Organisations are now legally required to Garda Vet Staff and Volunteers for certain roles?

We know this can be intimidating and it can be difficult to know where to start. Dún Laoghaire Rathdown Volunteer Centre can help.

We provide small local organisations with a Garda Vetting Service, processing all their Garda Vetting forms and providing the support and training needed to get started.

Step 1

Decide whether your organisation needs to Garda vet volunteers and staff, not all roles require vetting, if you're unsure please call us on 01 441 4444

Step 2

If you need vetting, register for our Information Session, this session is just 1.5 hours and will cover everything you need to know, to start Garda Vetting (Details over leaf)

Step 3

Register with our Centre's Garda Vetting Service and decide which roles require vetting in your organisation

Step 4

Start the process of getting volunteers and staff to complete relevant paperwork and submit details to the Volunteer Centre

Step 5

The Volunteer Centre will process all your Garda Vetting for you, through the National Vetting Bureau and return it completed, to your organisation.
